

YOUTH ORGANIZATION BANNERS Information Sheet 2017 Wisconsin State Fair



Wisconsin State Fair encourages each 4-H county, Boy Scout pack, Girl Scout troop and FFA chapter to showcase their organization/group by displaying a banner at the Fair. The banner will be displayed in the Youth Expo Hall. Banners become the property of Wisconsin State Fair and will be hung each year during the Fair as space allows.

Banners printed on vinyl are preferred. If submitting a banner made of dense fabric or felt, please ensure that all parts are securely sewn on the banner so that they do not fall off when stored or displayed. Please do not submit banners made of foam or kite-like material.

4-H counties, Boy Scout packs, Girl Scout troops and FFA chapters are encouraged to showcase your organization's name and logo on the banner so that it can be seen by Fairgoers when displayed in the Youth Expo Hall.

Banner specifications are as follows:

- 4' wide by 6' tall
- suitable method of hanging (room for at least 2" dowel)
- banners must be vinyl, dense fabric or felt (no foam or kite-like material)
- bright eye-catching colors
- include your county, pack, troop or chapter name and organizational logo
