Dog Project Details

Dog project training will be held on TUESDAYS starting June 6th at the Vernon County Fairgrounds and will continue through the end of August, weather permitting. There will be no class on July 4th.

5pm- Advanced Agility (by prior approval)

The Advanced Agility class is for participants who can run sequences of greater than 12 obstacles and are competent on all equipment with the exception of weave poles. Beginner participants will be asked to move to Advanced as their skills progress. The first 15 minutes will be utilized for moving obstacles and course set up. Parents should plan to assist with course set up. Beginner Agility participants are welcome to observe the Advanced Agility class, beginning at 5:15pm (without their dogs).

6pm- Beginner Agility and Obedience

Beginner Agility class and Obedience class will run concurrently. Participants wishing to do both Beginner Agility and Obedience will rotate between the two classes, either individually or in small groups. Parents should plan on assisting Beginner Agility participants.

All **agility** participants should plan on bringing the following to each training session:

- *Flat buckle collar (no choke chains or harnesses permitted for safety reasons)
- *Leash
- *An assortment (at least 3 different kinds) of soft treats cut into small bites
- *A treat pouch that attaches to the body via clip or belt to store treats
- *At least one toy or ball the dog enjoys playing with
- * Water and water bowl for dog
- *Water bottle for participant
- *Crate for dog to stay in when not on working the obstacles, or a parent must plan to always be available to hold the dog as needed (when the participant needs to walk a course, etc)

All **obedience** participants should plan on bringing the following to each training session:

- 6 foot nylon or leather leash, treats, and possibly slip collar/choke chain

Additional Information:

*Cost: \$15.00 per participant or \$25.00 per family for one class (obedience OR agility)
\$25.00 per participant or \$40.00 per family for both classes (obedience AND agility)

*It is important to NOT feed your dog dinner before coming to class. A hungry dog will be more motivated for training.
